

State's RV Parks Among Best in U.S.

You may think world-class vacation destinations are too far from home; however, Pennsylvania RV owners will only need to make a short drive to find top-of-the-line travel accommodations.

In a recent survey conducted by the national Association of RV Parks and Campgrounds, seven of 31 independent, privately owned U.S. campgrounds given an overall A-rating are located in Pennsylvania.

Several of the A-rated state campgrounds are also PRVCA members: Gettysburg Campground, Gettysburg; Keen Lake Camping and Cottage Resort, Waymart; and Mountain Vista Campground, East Stroudsburg.

Nearly 17,000 campers and RVers took part in the Internet survey, which evaluated guest experiences at 1,840 independent campgrounds and RV resorts across the country.

“Sixteen of the nation’s 31 top parks in our survey also received A ratings last year, but we also had 15 parks that received A ratings for the first time,” said Bob MacKinnon, president and CEO of GuestRated.com, which conducted the online survey for the National Association of RV Parks and Campgrounds.

GuestRated.com provides Internet survey tools to some 3,600 parks affiliated with the National Association of RV Parks and Campgrounds.
