- Must be in 11th grade or higher
- Gain hands-on experience at a local RV dealership
- Training will prepare you to become a Certified RV Technician
- Eligible for RV Maintenance study on-campus at Northampton Community College or the Distance Learning Program

Distance Learning

- RV Technician Training Program through Northampton Community College Distance Learning Program
- Non-credit program of twenty individual courses

- Upon completion of all courses, students get a specialized training diploma

FREE MATCO Tool Kit

- Must be a PA RV Technician Apprentice
- The Foundation owns the tool kit until completion of apprenticeship
- Should the apprentice withdraw or not satisfactorily complete the program, the tool kit will come back to the Foundation and can be transferred to another apprentice



DISCOUNTED MATCO Tool Kit

- Must be enrolled as an NRVTI student on-site or involved in the Distance Learning Program
- Must complete a minimum of 50% of the total training hours offered
- You must provide proof of enrollment and completion of training and it must be signed by the training institute administrator
